## SCHUBACH AVIATION PLEDGES \$8,000 DONATION TO HELEN WOODWARD ANIMAL CENTER VIA "ONE CENT PER MILE" PROMOTION

In addition to making monetary contributions, Schubach Aviation will also promote Helen Woodward Animal Center's fundraising events in its full-page ads, which will feature celebrity surf dogs Dozer and Nani. A four-hour-long photo session was held recently at Schubach Aviation's Palomar Airport hangar to photograph Dozer and Nani posed inside one of the firm's two Challenger 601 private jets.
